The Georgia Commission for Service and Volunteerism (GCSV) is seeking proposals from eligible organizations interested in operating AmeriCorps programs to strengthen communities through national service and volunteerism. Eligible organizations include non-profit and faith-based organizations with 501(c)3 status in the State of Georgia, educational institutions, and state and local government entities.

First-time applicants are encouraged to submit applications. First-time applicants may submit requests for a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 10 Member Service Years (MSY) or its equivalent in the form of full-time, half-time, quarter-time or minimum-time members. [Note: **One MSY** is equivalent to one full-time AmeriCorps member. AmeriCorps funds are contingent on the number of MSYs requested by the program.]

Formula applications will be due to GCSV no later than 3:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 13, 2018.

Both new and re-competing applicants are encouraged to attend at least one of the following workshops.
